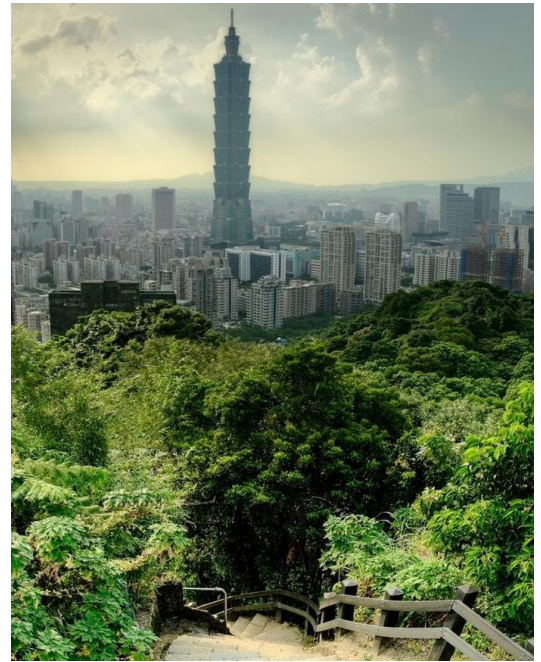

Program Summaries

ACES in South Africa: Children and Families Service Learning

Summer or Winter Break

The program consists of a 20-day study tour to Cape Town, South Africa featuring cultural/historical tours and 2 weeks of volunteer work. Volunteer opportunities include, but are not limited to, HIV/AIDS education, childcare, healthcare, and community projects in Cape Town and surrounding townships. This program also includes a course during the previous semester.

ACES Study & Intern in South Africa: Fall Semester

In this program, students study in Durban and intern in Cape Town. Coursework at the University of KwaZulu Natal provides the foundation for understanding historical and contemporary South Africa. Upon completion of coursework, students will move to Cape Town to complete a 12-week internship related to their field of interest.

IAGE the KU Leuven-Illinois Experience: Encountering Europe through the Lens of Social Science: Fall or Spring Semester

At this Illinois Center abroad, European and US students participate in common classes and curriculum to explore the social and demographic transitions that accompany globalization. The program is available in both semesters, however, the spring semester offers core courses in family dynamics and population change.

IAGE Exchange: Uppsala University: Fall or Spring Semester

Uppsala University hosts many international students, and makes it a priority to include all students in the university community. A variety of courses are offered in HDFS-related subjects. Research opportunities are also available for interested students.

ACES in Brazil at University of Vicosa: Fall or Spring Semester

Located north of Rio de Janeiro, the University of Vicosa offers courses in Housekeeping, Early Childhood Education, and the Social Sciences that translate well to students in HDFS at the University of Illinois. This program requires at least 2 semesters of Portuguese language experience.

ACES in New Zealand at Massey University: Fall or Spring Semester

This program offers a variety of coursework for HDFS students, including Human Development, Studies of Infant and Toddlers, and Adolescent Development. There is additional coursework available that fulfills ACES electives as well as general education requirements.
